Adelaide gets extra flights to New Zealand

Air New Zealand has added two flights to its Adelaide-Auckland service starting in October this year, bringing the number of flights on the service to five a week. Air New Zealand launched its direct flights between Auckland and Adelaide a year ago. The two additional services would operate on Mondays and Thursdays.

Adelaide Airport Wins and New Security Measures for International Flights

Adelaide Airport was named as the world's second best airport in the 5 -15 million passenger category at the Airports Council International 2006 awards for service quality announced in Dubai recently.

The Australian Government's new security measures for international flights to and from Australia come into force on 31 March 2007. Passengers will only be able to bring liquids, aerosols and gels in their carry-on baggage if they are in containers of no more than 100ml and fit comfortably in a one litre transparent plastic resealable bag.
