Cathay Pacific to fly daily from October 1st

Cathay Pacific Airways is to increase its' four times a week Adelaide service to a daily service from 1st October. The extra flights will operate to the same schedule and triangular routing as the current flights – Adelaide-Melbourne-Hong Kong, then Hong Kong-Adelaide.

Departing Adelaide at 11:00am (1100) daily, the flight arrives in Hong Kong at 10:05pm (2205), offering excellent connections to London, Rome, and Paris as well as Beijing, Seoul and Los Angeles. It will also connect with flights to Vancouver, Bahrain and Dubai three times a week and to Delhi four times a week. Southbound the daily flights depart Hong Kong at 11:35pm and arrive in Adelaide at 9:40am
